CONSUMER MOTOR VEHICLE RECOVERY CORPORATION NOTICE TO CONSUMERS

You may be eligible to receive a payment from the Consumer Motor Vehicle Recovery Fund if (1) you purchased or leased a motor vehicle from a licensed dealer (or lessor-retailer), or consigned your vehicle to a licensed dealer for sale, and (2) you have a claim for the loss of money that arose after July 1, 2008, resulting from the dealer's failure to do any of the following:

- Transfer your license or registration fees to DMV.
- Pay you the agreed upon amount after the consignment sale of your vehicle.
- Pay off the agreed upon amount for your trade-in vehicle when you purchased or leased your car.
- Provide good title, free of any lien or other claim.
- Pay third parties for insurance, service contracts, or goods or services purchased through the dealer.

The application must be filed within one year of the date upon which the dealer or lessor-retailer ceased selling or leasing motor vehicles to the general public or became subject to a petition in bankruptcy. Late claims are not eligible for payment.

If you think you may have an eligible claim, complete the Consumer Motor Vehicle Recovery Fund Claim Form and return it with copies of the requested documents that support your claim to the address provided in the Claim Form. Do not send your completed claim form by e-mail. Claim forms received by e-mail will not be processed.
